

RULES & REGULATIONS



- All classes are run according to the current rules and specifications of the USEF where applicable.
- 2. Every animal entered for competition shall be under the control of show management; but Brushy Hill Farm will in no way be responsible for any loss, accident, or damage that may occur by fire or otherwise and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor, spectator, trainer, and attendant hold Brushy Hill Farm, and its members, employees, and agents, harmless for any loss or damage that may occur to any persons, animals, or property at the show.
- 3. If any questions or disputes arise, same will be referred to the show committee, whose decision shall be final.
- 4. Entry fee is \$35 per class. Cash, check, Venmo and Zelle payments are accepted at the Secretary's Desk.
- 5. **Entries close 48 hours prior to the show.** You may enter by email brushyhillfarm@gmail.com or phone/text (203) 470-4353.
- 6. Post entries will be accepted for a fee of \$25 for each horse/rider combination. There will be no penalty for entering or scratching additional classes the day of the show.
- 7. \$50 fee for any returned checks, or unpaid entries that must be billed.
- 8. Non-show fee \$30 for horse/ponies not showing in horse show.
- 9. Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, divide classes, and alter the schedule based on entries. In addition, the right is reserved to refuse any entry before the start of the competition without being liable for compensation. Exhibitors will be notified.
- 10. Six ribbons will be awarded in each class unless otherwise noted. Championship and Reserve in each division.
- 11. The Series High Point Awards will be awarded to the top 3 riders at the November 2, 2025 show. A rider must compete in 2 of the 3 shows in the same division to be eligible. Riders will accumulate points over the 2025 horse show series.
- 12. Points will go: 1st-10pts, 2nd-6pts, 3rd-4pts, 4th-2pts, 5th-1pt, 6th-1/2pt.
- 13. Hunter classes to be judged on soundness and performance unless otherwise noted.
- 14. Riders are to be properly attired for all classes. ASTM/SEI Approved protective headgear is required at all times when mounted.
- 15. **No Dogs** or other pets are permitted on grounds.
- 16. There is **No Smoking** permitted on grounds.
- 17. Warm-ups for each level will be scheduled throughout the day. Schooling and lunging will be permitted in authorized areas only.

Open to all riders who have not competed in any other classes. Riders may be asked to trot. Riders to be judged on elementary fundamentals of horsemanship. Riders may NOT cross enter into any other classes.

Cross rails not to exceed 15" and course is once around at the trot.

Riders will be asked to flat at the walk, trot and canter in both directions of the ring. Riders will canter individually. Riders may cross enter into Short / Long Stirrup only. Cross rails not to exceed 15" and course is once around at the trot.

They will be judged on manners, suitability and performance. Diagonals will not count. Riders may NOT cross enter into any walk trot canter divisions.

Cross rails not to exceed 15" and course is once around at the trot.

Open to horses and ponies. No age limitations and no rider restrictions. Simple lead changes and trotting in corners will not be penalized. The same horse/rider combination may not compete in more than one fence height at the same show. Fences not to exceed 18".
